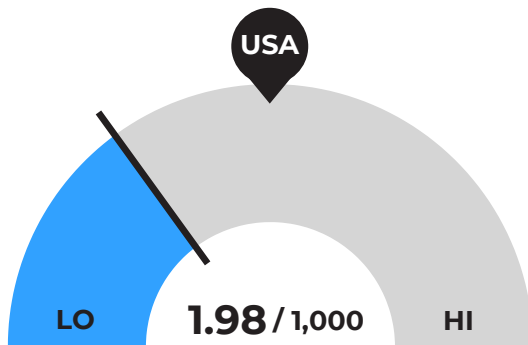
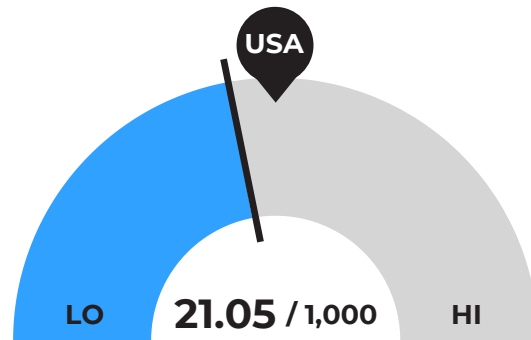


Asheville MSA Crime Rates (2018)
