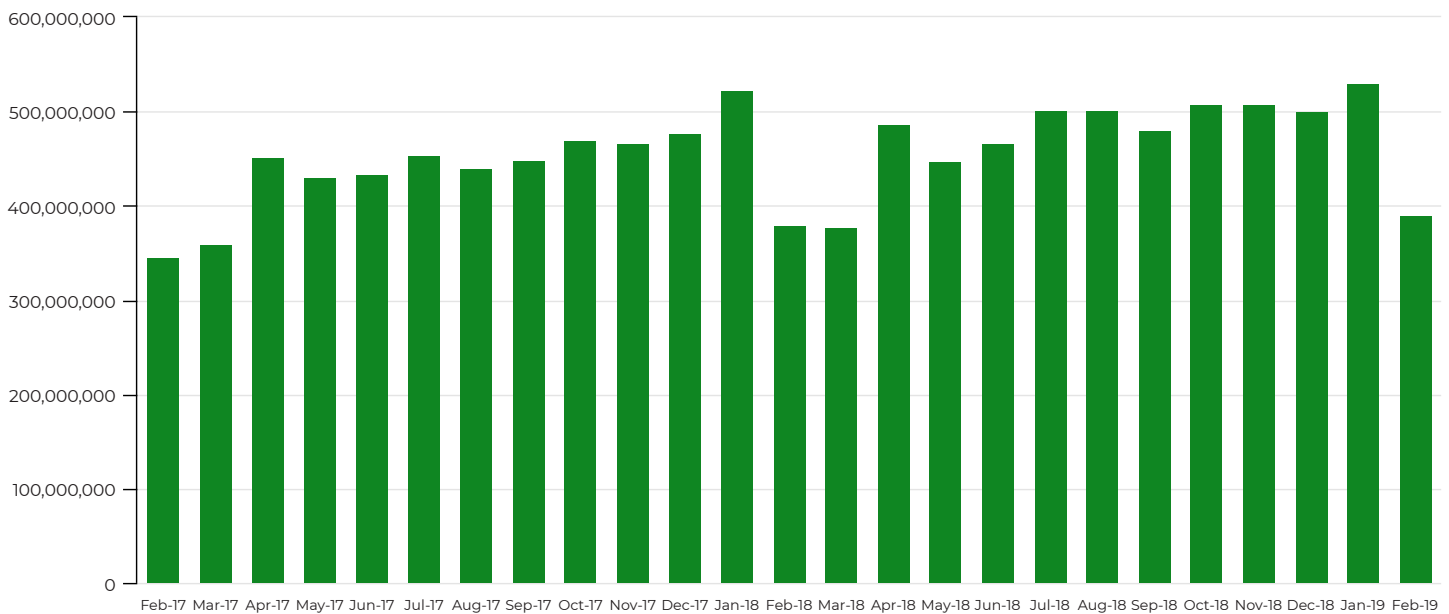


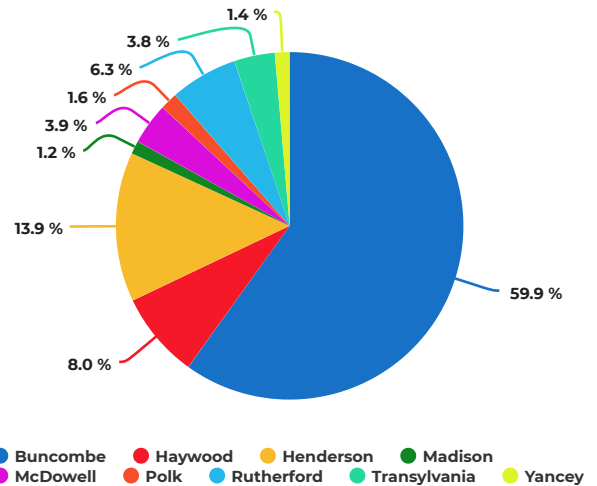

Note: Retail Sales versus Taxable Sales: In Fiscal Year 2005-06 the Streamlined Sales Tax Agreement required a change in the Sales & Use Tax return so that not all taxpayers report Gross Retail Sales. Beginning with the report for July 2005, the North Carolina Department of Revenue reports only Gross Collections and Taxable Sales.
